Mr. Curtis Clay, Chairman, submitted the Finance Committee report.


Mr. Jerry Blair, Chairman, submitted the Personnel Committee report.

Mr. Reggie Johnson, Chairman, submitted the Road Maintenance & Construction Committee report.


