The Vernon Parish Police Jury met in Special Session, Friday, December 28, 2018 at 4 p.m. in the Police Jury meeting room with the following members

**PRESENT:** James B. "Jim" Tuck – President, Alton "David" Fox, Jackie Grimes, Reginald "Reggie" Johnson, Charnel Bailey, Melvin Haymon, David Brister, Curtis Clay – Vice President, and Kenny Haymon. The following members were **ABSENT:** Marvin Hilton, Jerry Blair, and Joseph "Bo" Cryer.

The Vernon Parish Police Jury was convened as the governing authority of the Parish of Vernon, by Mr. James B. "Jim" Tuck, President, and was then ready for the business on the agenda.

The invocation was given by Mr. David Fox and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Melvin Haymon.

The President asked if there was any public comment on any agenda items; there was none.

A motion was made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Grimes and carried, to approve liquor license received from Sarah J. Johnson for The Beer Store, LLC, 12808 Hwy 10, Pitkin.

A motion was made by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Brister and carried, to approve request to hire the following individuals to fill vacancies in the Building & Grounds Maintenance Department:

- Mr. Billy Weatherford, Building & Grounds Maintenance Supervisor
- Mr. Casey Lynn Cryer, Building & Grounds Maintenance

Both positions are subject to a 6-month probation period

A motion was made by Mr. Clay, seconded by Mr. K. Haymon and carried, to approve the amended 2018 budget and the proposed 2019 budget for the operation of the North Louisiana Criminalistics Laboratory Commission; annual budget must be

approved by a majority of the parish level governing body in the laboratory service area.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Haymon, seconded by Mr. Clay and carried, to approve invoice received for Workers Compensation Insurance, \$167,596.00 (decrease of \$54,835.00 from last year) for the year 2019.

A motion was made by Mr. Clay, seconded by Mr. K. Haymon and carried, to enter into public hearing to hear input on the amended budget for 2018 and the proposed budget for the year 2019.

There was no public comment. The Treasurer presented the budget to the members of the Police Jury.


A motion was made by Mr. Clay, seconded by Mr. Brister and carried, to return to Special Call agenda.
