

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

VERNON PARISH POLICE JURY PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The Vernon Parish Police Jury will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, January 18, 2022 at 10 a.m., during the Regular Police Jury meeting, at the Parish Government Complex Building, in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, 300 S. 3rd St., Leesville, Louisiana, to hear public input on the following items:

- A proposed ordinance to declare the malapportionment status of the Vernon Parish Police Jury utilizing the population data from the 2020 federal decennial census; and otherwise, to provide with respect thereto.
- A proposed ordinance to amend **Section 17-7(a) - Heavy hauling regulations**, of the Vernon Parish Code of Ordinances to read as follows: Anyone hauling (in excess of 25 tons) on parish roads for large construction, development or industrial projects, for removal of natural resources such as timber, minerals, gas, oil, etc., including but not limited to drilling operations, and for any other heavy hauling must request a permit from the Vernon Parish Police Jury Public Works Department. Heavy Haulers must register with the Public Works Department prior to obtaining a Heavy Hauling Permit.
- A proposed ordinance to amend **Section 17-47 – Inspection of parish roads**, of the Vernon Parish Code of Ordinances to read as follows: When the repairs are completed, the permit holder shall request an inspection by the parish road manager/parish engineer. If, after inspection, the repairs are found to be unsatisfactory, the permit holder shall be given fifteen (15) days in which to correct the deficiencies, in accordance with the specifications of the parish road manager/parish engineer. ~~If, after the expiration of fifteen (15) days, the permit holder has failed or refused to effect the specified repairs, the permit fee shall be forfeited and applied to the parish general road and bridge fund, to provide for the supervision and administration of this article~~

This item was introduced at the December 20, 2021 regular meeting and will be considered for adoption at the January 18, 2022 regular Police Jury meeting.
